

Handwriting sheet: Precursive Arrow worksheet

Word list: Spelling longer *ff* words

In this word list, we will explore longer words that contain the double *ff* spelling. The same rules that apply to shorter words also extend to these longer examples.

When a word has the *f* sound following a short vowel, you should double the *f*. However, if the *f* sound is followed by a consonant, it should not be doubled.

For instance, in *coffee*, the *f* follows the short /o/ sound, so is doubled.

As you engage with these activities, pay close attention to how these rules work and practise using these words correctly in your writing.
