

Handwriting sheet: Precursive Arrow worksheet

Word list: *aw* words

In these words, the spelling pattern *aw* represents the /or/ sound, like in the words *saw*, *jaw*, and *draw*

While there are a few other ways of spelling the /or/ sound in English, there are three common situations in which it is likely that you will need to use the *aw* spelling pattern:

- 1) At the end of a word, like in *paw* and *claw*.
- 2) Before the letter 'l', such as in *crawl* and *shawl*.
- 3) Before the letter 'n', for example in *lawn* and *yawn*.

Occasionally the *aw* will also appear at the start of the word, like in *awkward* or *awning*.
