Word list: -ore words

If the sound /or/ is on the end of a word, it is usually spelled with the letters *-ore*. Some common examples include *shore*, *core*, and *store*. This spelling pattern helps distinguish these words from others that use *or*, *aw*, or *au* for the same sound. Learning this pattern will help improve spelling accuracy. Regular practice with spelling activities will reinforce your recognition of *-ore* words and their correct usage in writing.
