Word list: ow words

Say the word *out*. Can you hear a sound like the word '*ow*' when you say it? That's the /*ou*/ sound! Sometimes, this sound is written using the letters *ow*.

There are three tricks you can use to help you remember when you need to use the letters *ow* to spell the /ou/ sound.

- 1) Use the *ow* spelling pattern if the /ou/ sound is at the end of a word, for example: *crow*, *vow*, or *bow*.
- 2) Use the letters ow if the /ou/ sound falls before the letter I, for example: owl, howl, or scowl.
- 3) Use the *ow* letter combination if the letter *n* comes after the */ou/* sound, for example: *clown*, *frown*, or *down*.
