Spelling list: Some more ar words

Let's continue exploring the *ar* spelling pattern with some 2-syllable words. Can you spot the /ar/ sound in each example? Click the speaker at the start of some words to listen for the /ar/ vowel sound as you read along.

In English, *ar* often appears in the middle of a word, like in *garden*, *carpet*, and *harvest*, though it can appear elsewhere, too. As you go through each word, pay attention to where the /ar/ sound falls, and try out different spelling activities and games.

barber The **barber** cut Tim's hair really short.

carpet There was blue **carpet** on the floor.

carton Would you like a **carton** of orange juice?

garden There are nine trees in my garden.

garlic I do not like **garlic**.

harvest The wheat is ready for **harvest**.

market The bus stops very near the **market** .

partner My **partner** does all the cooking.

party Will Jeff invite us to his **party**?

scarlet The gorgeous dress was **scarlet** and gold.

target He shot the **target** with great accuracy.

varnish He painted **varnish** on the wooden gate.
