## Spelling list: Other ways of spelling the /ar/ sound

palm The **palm** tree swayed in the wind.

calf One of our cows has just had a **calf** .

half Noah ate **half** the cake.

father My **father** is called Andrew.

rather It's **rather** rude to swear.

bath She had a long soak in the **bath**.

path The **path** was rough and rocky.

craft Thatching is an ancient **craft**.

ask I want to **ask** Nina to my party.

basket The **basket** was full of edible treats.

plant My cactus is my favourite **plant**.

class We are studying angles in our geometry **class**.

glass Be careful not to break that **glass**.

chance I have very little **chance** of winning.

dance My favourite **dance** is the waltz.

advance They planned their trip well in **advance**.

blast There was a large **blast** in the quarry.

last Did you receive my last letter?

castle The old **castle** has a moat.
