done At last I've **done** all my work.

gone They've **gone** to Florida for a week.

some Would you like **some** fish and chips?

come I'll **come** round to your house.

were What **were** you doing out late last night?

before Pierce the lid **before** cooking.

sure Make **sure** the plant has water.

because I like you **because** you understand me.

friend I to the end will be your **friend**.

build They wanted to **build** a house.

people There are lots of **people** in the park.

beautiful That's a **beautiful** dress you're wearing.

their Their means 'belonging to them.'.
