do	What can I <b>do</b> to help?
does	Why <b>does</b> this word look strange?
done	At last I've <b>done</b> all my work.
go	Where did you <b>go</b> last night?
goes	Jack <b>goes</b> swimming every Saturday.
gone	They've <b>gone</b> to Florida for a week.
