Spelling list: be words

Words that start with the prefix be often use a single e to create the long /e/sound.

Learning words with this pattern will help build a strong vocabulary and reinforce understanding of common English prefixes. Practice these examples to learn with how *be* words are used in sentences!

because You should not persecute someone **because** of their beliefs.

become Peter would like to **become** a doctor.

before She ate her dinner **before** going out.

behind They hid **behind** a tree.

belong That book doesn't **belong** to the library.

below He lives in the apartment **below** me.

between An alley runs **between** the houses.

beware The sign warned us to **beware** of the bears.

beyond He lives just **beyond** the hill.
