

## Spelling list: *re* words

The prefix *re* often signals repetition or a return to an earlier state, and it uses just the letter *e* for the long /e/ sound. Words like *repeat* and *return* reflect this idea of doing something again or going back to a previous place.

Explore the following *re* words to become more familiar with how they're used in different contexts.

react	We didn't expect her to <b>react</b> so quickly.
recall	Sam could not <b>recall</b> where he put his key.
recent	Is that a <b>recent</b> photo?
record	She completed the race in <b>record</b> time.
reflect	The light will <b>reflect</b> from the white walls.
refund	I'm sending this back for a <b>refund</b> .
region	Wine is grown in this <b>region</b> of France.
relax	She took a hot bath to help her <b>relax</b> .
rely	We can <b>rely</b> on her.
remind	She asked her mother to <b>remind</b> her what time the appointment was.
repeat	Using a stencil allows a painter to <b>repeat</b> a pattern.
reply	Please <b>reply</b> to my email tonight.
require	I <b>require</b> your answer by Monday.
return	I need to <b>return</b> these shoes as they don't fit me.
