

## Spelling list: -o words - food

The long -o sound at the end of these food-related words is spelled with just the letter o .

This group of words includes items from cuisines around the world. *Tomato* and *potato* are everyday staples in many diets, while *avocado* is a creamy fruit often used in salads or sandwiches. Words like *taco* and *risotto* reflect dishes with origins in Mexico and Italy.

These words are excellent for expanding vocabulary related to international foods.
