

## Spelling list: *er* and *ear* words

These words use the letters *er* or *ear* to spell the sound /er/. This list includes words where the letters *er* or *ear* spell the /er/ sound. You'll find examples like *fern* , *serve* , *learn* , and *yearn* that showcase the different ways this sound appears in English words.
