

Spelling list: Year 3, Term 1, Week 7: *un-* prefix

Students learn how the *un-* prefix changes the meaning of words to their opposites. This pattern is useful for expanding vocabulary.

early	I'm not late, I'm early .
earth	The gardener dug into the earth .
unable	I was unable to spell the word.
unclean	Do not drink the unclean water.
unfasten	The boy found it difficult to unfasten his button.
unhappy	I was unhappy when the snow melted.
unlucky	We were unlucky to lose the game by one goal.
untruthful	He was being untruthful .
unwanted	We gave the unwanted toys to the charity shop.
unwell	I knew I was unwell when I started to feel feverish.
