Spelling list: Year 3, Term 2, Week 5: -ly suffix (change y to i)

In these words, students will practise adding the *-ly* suffix to adjectives ending in *y* , which involves changing *y* to *i* . These adverbs modify how actions are performed.

accidently I accidentally broke a plate.

actually I don't **actually** want to go to the event.

angrily The bull charged **angrily** across the field.

easily I should beat my next opponent **easily** .

fussily I **fussily** tidied the room.

greedily The dog ate its food **greedily**.

happily The children **happily** went out to play.

merrily The children played **merrily** in the snow.

occasionally I occasionally go swimming.

sensibly The children walked **sensibly** in the corridor.
