Words ending in -ous often describe qualities. You'll learn how to spell them and when to use them correctly in writing.

dangerous	It is <b>dangerous</b> to walk so close to the edge of the cliff.
enormous	Have you read the book about the <b>enormous</b> crocodile?
famous	A wall plaque shows where the <b>famous</b> explorer lived.
jealous	He was <b>jealous</b> of his brother's new bike.
mountainous	A large part of Austria is <b>mountainous</b> .
notice	To perceive something is to <b>notice</b> it.
poisonous	The snake's venom was <b>poisonous</b> .
special	A birthday is a <b>special</b> day.
tremendous	The thunder made a <b>tremendous</b> noise.
woman	We need to appoint a new <b>woman</b> for this job.
