

## Spelling list: Year 6, Term 1, Week 3: *-ant* , *-ance* , *-ancy* endings

Words that end in *-ant* , *-ance* and *-ancy* often describe qualities or people. Try breaking them down into the root word and suffix.

expectancy	Life <b>expectancy</b> is the average number of years a person is expected to live.
guarantee	I <b>guarantee</b> if you learn your spellings, you'll do well!
harass	It is not kind to tease or <b>harass</b> other students.
hesitant	John was <b>hesitant</b> to stand up and speak.
observant	The security guard was very <b>observant</b> .
recognise	I didn't <b>recognise</b> you with your new hair cut.
relevant	That isn't very <b>relevant</b> to the conversation.
restaurant	The food served at the <b>restaurant</b> was delicious.
tolerant	Being <b>tolerant</b> means respecting people's differences, even if we don't agree with them.
