

Spelling list: Year 6, Term 1, Week 7: Suffixes (vowel letters)

These suffixes begin with vowel letters and are used to change the meaning of word. Notice how the spelling of the root word changes when the suffix is added.

preference	He has a preference for classical music.
preferential	Bingo the dog got preferential treatment to the cat, because he was so cute.
referee	The referee blew his whistle at the end of the game.
reference	If you are stuck, use the instruction book for reference .
referral	He needed a referral for his new job.
referred	The matter was referred to the head teacher.
rhyme	Does the poem rhyme ?
soldier	The poem is about a soldier in the war.
sufficient	Do you have sufficient money for a bus ride home?
transferred	The footballer was transferred to another team.
