snare The rabbit was trapped in a **snare**.

stare Is it rude to **stare**?

care Take care not to skid on the ice.

fare He lost his bus **fare** and had to walk all the way home.

mare The **mare** took care of her new foal.

ware She had a beautiful collection of crystal ware.

blare I heard the **blare** of a siren whizzing past.

glare The witch gave the little boy an evil **glare**.

share I will **share** my dessert with him.
