## Spelling list: ei saying /ay/

The *i before* e *except after* c spelling rule applies to the long e/sound, but the words in this list feature a long e/a/sound. This means they're spelt with the letter combination ei. Spot this pattern in words like e/vein, e/reign, and e/ight.
