Spelling list: ei saying /ay/

These *ei* words do not follow the rule *i before e except after c* . This is because they have the long /a/ sound.

This list includes words like *weigh*, *freight*, and *neighbour*, which show how the letters *ei* can be pronounced as /ay/ in certain cases. These words may look tricky at first, but once you learn the pattern, they will become easier to spell. To help you with these words, try a *Listen and Spell* test.

sleigh The kids enjoyed the **sleigh** ride.
